

CIO Tier1 Page Design

The CIO page will be the entry point for the CIO sub-site. The CIO content categories will include...

- CIO FAQ's
- Technical Top Stories
- Modernization Program
- Standards
- VDC Operations Reports
- Software Downloads
- Hot Technology Links
- eCommerce
- Innovations
- IT Management
- IT Services

CIO Splash page will include the standard SFA Task Bar containing links to...

- Vision/Mission
- People
- Library
- IRB Activities
- IPT Activities
- Career Planning

The presentation scheme will follow the standard menu layout configuration with the SFA left-nav, the SFA top-nav, and the SFA Task Bar displayed appropriately.

The CIO Content menu will be represented graphically using a collage of images depicting CIO activities. CIO Tier 2 pages will use a representative image from the Tier 1 menu collage to tie the look-and-feel together as a user moves through the CIO sub-site.

The *Top Stories* Tier 2 page will be accessed through a teaser display of content containing a link to the "full story" details page. Archived article access will be made available through a drop-down box, which will display article titles and dates.

CIO Tier 2 Page Design

Tier 2 navigation will include access to all the major content groups within the CIO sub-site. Each Tier 2 page will display a separate image from the Tier 1 menu collage. In the case of Tier 3 level navigation, the representative image will conversely run throughout that tier. Navigation for Tier 2 pages will include access to all section pages as well as a link back to the menu of origin.

Lower Level Content Pages

Content level pages will follow the graphical design of the tier in which they are found. The SFA Task Bar will not be visible on these lower level content pages. Navigation across the lower level and a link to the page of origin will be displayed across the bottom of each page. A link back to the page of origin will also appear at the top of each content page.
