<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Section 2, 1st sub-bullet – Statement “... for award years 0203 and 0304”. What years are these (e.g., CY or FY 2002/2003 and 2003/2004)? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 0203 and 0304 refer to the Student Loan Award Years. This is the common and accepted way for documenting the years. The sentence was updated to include Student Loan Award Years.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Section 2, 5th major bullet – Statement “... in line with the standards of the other EAI enabled servers”. What are these server standards? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The bullet was updated to include the following: Previously, the EAI software on SU35E18 consisted only of client versions for MQSeries and Data Integrator. This differed from all other EAI servers which are installed with server versions of the software. The client software did not provide the reliability compared with the server versions. An effort was undertaken to replace the client with server software. Replacing the software required MQSeries configuration changes including the creation of a new MQSeries Queue Manager –DMP1. All application interfaces to the Financial and Credit Data Marts on SU35E18 now route through this new queue manager. This effort was completed this reporting period.

Has the schedule for these updates changed since the last report (i.e., 117.1.1d)? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Added Section 4.2.1 Virtual Data Center Hardware Refresh which provides current plan dates. Updated Section 2, 6th sub-bullet and referenced Section 4.2.1
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Section 3 – This section is the same as the previous report (i.e., 117.1.1d). Have there been any changes to the EAI architecture? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No updates have been made to the EAI architecture. A statement was added indicating no changes were made to the EAI architecture this reporting period.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Appendix A <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ SU35E16 was listed as a host name in the previous Appendix a, but is not present in this new version of Appendix A ○ HPN3 was listed as a host name in the previous Appendix A, now is identified as Rp7410-3 in this new version of Appendix A. ○ Are both WebSphere MQ Integrator versions “2.0.1” and “2.01.” used? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ In Section 5.1.1 of the previous report (117.1.1d) indicates that SU22E28 has replaced SU35E16 as the EAI Development server. SU35E16 is no longer a part of the EAI infrastructure. ○ Added text to Section 5.1.2 to note replacement of HPN3 with new rp7410-3 server. Appendices A and D were updated to reflect the server change. ○ The “2.01.” is a typo. The version was updated in Appendix A to “2.0.1”.
