**II. Agenda**

- A. Review CPS Routing Identifiers (ID) and their relationships to other Partners responsible for routing schools, and others through the Enterprise.

**III. Outcomes**

1. Angie Iwanicki provided the following additional details about the Federal School Code:
  - a. The “G Code” can be FFEL, DL or both
  - b. For FFEL schools, the G Code always represents a Main campus while an “E Code” Always represents and additional location
  - c. The G code will always be the same as the OPE ID
2. CPS used to receive the PELL\_IDs from RFMS (being retired). The Pell code is assigned by the case team.
3. Angie said that there is a reference table containing the schools’ information
4. For “04-05”, CPS is eliminating the existing fields for DUNS, TIN, PELL and DL IDs from the Federal School Code File
5. Angie said there is a point where the G codes and not always the same as the OPE ID
6. Angie said that Changes of Affiliation do not necessarily directly affect the Federal School code. For example, she said that if “Main School # 1” sells a Branch Campus to “Main School 2” CPS would still want that Branch campus to continue top use the same Federal School Code
7. Angie said that the Federal School Code is effectively created in PEPS given that PEPS initially “puts it in the crosswalk”. Physically, it is currently generated in CPS. An effort is currently underway to move the creation responsibility from CPS to PEPS.
8. She provided the following review of terminology that tends to be associated with given systems:
  - a. CPS: Active / Inactive
  - b. PEPS: Approved / Unapproved
  - c. Others: Eligible / Ineligible
9. A “Preparer” using CPS must input their SSN & EIN (this allows CPS to produce report sometimes requested by OIG which allows individual submitters activity to be viewed in one report)
10. Angie said” for years we’ve been hoping to use the single ID like the OPE ID or DUNS, RID should stay focused on the improvements that will come after implementation”.
