II. Agenda

- A. Review Schools Portal Routing Identifiers (ID) and their relationships to other Partners responsible for routing schools, and others through the Enterprise.

III. Outcomes

1. Colleen Kennedy, of Schools Portal, said that there are approximately 10,000 Financial Aid Administrators (FAAs) among which 2,000 or more are registered users of IFAP
2. Some registered Users of IFAP/Schools Portal represent Lenders, Guarantee Agencies or other Professional Associations
3. The Schools Portal is the “jumping off point” from which schools can access all sites that they utilize (related to FSA)
4. Colleen was familiar with the “Common School Identifier” (CSID) approach and provided context on how such an approach could be integrated with the School’s Portal
5. The vision for the schools Portal is in line with the RID (formerly CSID) goals which will allow users to interact with FSA similarly to the way they are able to interact with a company like Dell via www.dell.com (where they have only one identifier which is input to the front-end which shows business processes as opposed to “systems”)
6. Colleen said the following: Probably the single most requested thing I can think of that schools say is ‘let me identify myself ONCE and then perform all my activities with that one ID’”
7. The only customization of the Portal (for a given user) is done by the user on the site
8. Per regulation, there are whole categories of “Dear Partner” letters on IFAP (including for GAs, Lenders, State Agencies etc.)
9. Colleen said that she would remain available to provide the Schools’ perspective to the RID team as needed
