General	Macro - LJ	I did not find the Diagrams as informative or helpful as the ones we currently use. The ones used for the last cycle 2001-2002 were very informative and data follow was clearly detailed.	
General	Macro - LJ	The Flow of Events was understandable and helpful but still lacked very important data (i.e. valid range, field length). I am unsure of the second column right and left arrows. Are the arrows for data flow? Wireframe column is a great idea.	
General	Macro - LJ	On the screen shot itself pages the screens are not very eye catching. I noticed that on all the screen certain numbers are underlined (hyperlinked). I logically believe that these links are the various links the user can click on for screen advancement. Last cycle once a screen was completed it was checked off (like a shopping list). What will happen with these links will the color under the link change or will that link (or prior screen) become disabled (i.e. Student completed 1 Info About You;)	
General	Macro - LJ	The buttons last cycle used fly over for the words to appear over the text (i.e. next button); The Use case button of the end of various screen have Save for Later, View FAFSA Summary, Exit buttons to appear each with the duplicated hyperlinked text below each button. Why not use the fly over?	
General	Macro - LJ	The Business Rules section is great.	
General	Macro - LJ	I like some of the field disabling logic used i.e. Student's Household Worksheet Your Spouse field is uneditable and depends on your marital status entered for question 15 of FAFSA. If selected I am Single, etc.....then insert 0 field is uneditable; If selected I am married, etc..... then insert 1 field is uneditable.....Great idea.....	
General	Macro - LJ	I thought the link for Table of Content last year was very helpful. Will table of Content appear on the screen or in Use Case Specifications?	
General	Macro - LJ	Currently in DDD whenever a change was made in the specs the old words would be strike through and the new words would be a lighter color. I have noticed in Use Case that when there is a change the strike through words would be replaced with underline words. This could be very difficult in testing because of the underlining that already appears on all the screens.(i.e. Parents' Income Estimator Worksheet, Flow of Events #13 appears to have the old striked through and the new underlined but below that Next and Previous appears underlined also.)	
General	Macro - RB	I also saw things require the use of the mouse (ex. Quest. 12, 16..) . Personally, I find the TAB keys more useful and faster. As far as the layout of this form, I didn't find it too hard to follow. The sections are worded differently and the layout of the help, save, printable summary, and other buttons is different (compared to what we've worked with), but I think its still fairly straight forward.

General	Macro - RB	Can anyone explain what's up with the layout of the Previous and Next buttons?	
General	Macro - RB	Under the heading Navigation Links, I noticed that some links show us the URLs and where they will take us, and the others don't.	
General	Macro - RW	The documentation from USI is very hard to follow and has no flow as the NCS DDD's do.	
General	Macro - RW	They are very different and additional time will be needed to make sure the integrity of our original documentation is maintained as we move into this new process for ED and NCS.	
General	Macro - RW	There is little, if any, instructions or guidelines with the documentation to instruct the tester on what needs to be tested or verified.	
General	Macro - RW	I also need to mention, each screen is very busy with text placement and has a lot more "movement" than what is in production for 2001-2002. Testing text placement alone is going to require a high degree of "attention to detail" and the functionality may be just as difficult.	
General	Macro - RW	The pages I have reviewed look as though they have been developed in an Apple (MAC) environment and who knows how this will react during testing.	
General	Macro - RW	We like the embedded version of the design documentation vs. the separate release of Use Case and Wireframe design documentation. Both versions are hard to follow and lack information we are accustomed to seeing. Will take longer for us to develop documentation and test cases to use for testing and ED review.	
General	Macro - RW	In the tables within the embedded documentation portion, there are little arrows facing left and right. I assume these arrows are referring to input and output however, there is no actual description or heading listed for that column.	
General	Macro - RW	Don't like the Command Buttons, they're too "wordy" and the layout is not uniformed though out.	
General	Macro - RW	The pages look very congested than we are used to, meaning, there are too many words and links which may confuse the users.	
General	Macro - RW	There is a lot of information in the embedded documentation portion which is good. However, the wording and test is a bit difficult to understand. More "White Space" is needed on wireframes.	
General	Macro - RW	Some of the "Diagrams or Flow Charts" don't seem to serve a purpose.	
General	Macro - RW	Watermarks on wireframe pages are not noticed at once, the user must sit back and review the page before they "pop-out" at you.
