



## **Executive Summary**

In order to meet SFA University's functional and user interface design requirements, several changes to Saba's web-based Learning Management System (LMS) were required. These changes fall into two distinct categories: web modifications and customizations.

### ***Web Modifications***

The web modifications focused on tailoring the look and feel of the site pages to meet requirements gathered from SFA University. The majority of the modifications concentrated on editing text or suppressing objects in the site. For example, the original LMS link to the Saba home page, "My Saba," was renamed "My Home" to make this link more descriptive and intuitive for the external end-user. A summary of these modifications and the modified files are included.

### ***Web Customizations***

The web customizations focused on incorporating new user processes into the LMS to meet requirements gathered from SFA University. Examples of web customizations include changing the login process to accommodate logging in using the Jamcracker application, the portal for the LMS, and modifying the registration process to collect accessibility requirements from the registrant. The customized script and web pages are included for reference.
