- A set of technology models and statements that guide FSA toward a consistent, compatible technology infrastructure based on FSA defined standards and supporting FSA’s modernization vision



This document is a reference tool for Federal Student Aid (FSA) technical architects, system administrators, application developers, procurement personnel, and others that require guidance on implementing FSA technical standards, standards products, and policies.

The guide is divided into technology groups including User Interface Services, Application Services, Enterprise Data Management, Distributed Computing, Data Interchange, Network Services, Operating Systems, Application Development, System Management, Security Services, and external environments. The following information is provided for each item in a technology group:

- *Brief Description* defines an item and describes the functions it performs.
- *Target Standards* are listed in a table that contains current and planned FSA solution standards.
- *Approved Standards* provides a detailed description of the policy underlying each technical standard or standard product and the rationale for the selection of a standard.
