## The Coach's Toolkit-----

100) He or she is recognized for their project management skills, communication skills, familiarity with FSA projects, interest and enthusiasm, follow through, responsiveness and interpersonal skills.

200) The SLC Toolkit divides the coaching process into this number of steps.

## **Documents and Processes**-----

100) The overall SLC framework is contained in this document.

*Answer: What is the SLC Process Guide?*

200) This document is used during the IRB investment management process to obtain funding for the project and will drive subsequent development, implementation, and verification of the solution.

*Answer: What is a Business Case?*

300) This document should provide enough information in order for the solution to be thoroughly developed.

*Answer: What is the Detailed Design Document?*

400) The first output of an IPT

*Answer: What is a Work Breakdown Structure?*

500) To estimate the needed resources and time to complete the Vision Phase outputs, a Project Manager can use this.

*Answer: What is an Acquisition Planning Estimating Worksheet? (found in the Solution Acquisition Process Guide)*

## **The SLC- Miscellaneous**-----

100) This is a framework containing a set of defined, documented and practiced processes that guide a solution from beginning to end within FSA.

*Answer: What is the FSA Solution Life Cycle?*

200) In each phase, all of these must be done to achieve compliance.

*Answer: What are critical tasks?*

300) It defines the relationship between requirements, documents, design and implementation of a solution.

*Answer: What is the Requirements Traceability Matrix?*

400) This group conducts an across the enterprise analysis and review of all IT initiatives. They review Business Cases and submit to IRB for approval.

*Answer: What is the DSG?*

500) This outlines performance targets and indicators for the solution which provides the capabilities to measure actual benefits.

*Answer: What is the Business Performance Model?*
