



## **SLC Awareness Training Requirements**

The primary objective of the Solution Life Cycle (SLC) Awareness effort is to increase awareness and use of the SLC across solution acquisition projects.

Additional awareness training objectives include:

- Raise awareness and understanding of the SLC
- Build common understanding of the process and artifacts within the SLC
- Create demand and excitement for the SLC and its future benefits
- Manage expectations (i.e., what is the SLC, what will it do for me)

### ***SLC Deployment Audience***

SLC Awareness training audience spans across FSA. Each audience is impacted differently by the implementation of the SLC, so some will be the focus of brief SLC Briefing sessions while others will be targeted to attend more extensive SLC Overview sessions. These audiences include:

- CIO eCAD
- CIO IT Management
- CIO IT Services
- CM Leads
- Decision Support Group
- Executive Sponsors
- Executive Steering Committee
- Information Technology Representative (ITR)
- Project Managers
- Quality Assurance (QA) Leads
- Requirements Development and Management (RDM) Leads
- Subject Matter Experts
- System Security Officer
- Transition to Support (TTS) Leads

These roles are typically filled by:

- SFA Business Unit ITRs
- SFA Project Managers
- Acquisitions and Contract Performance



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### ***SLC Briefing Sessions***

SLC briefing sessions are aimed at gaining awareness among SFA senior leadership, within the CIO organization and across Modernization Partner leadership and task order managers. The SLC briefing session consists of a 15-minute communication presentation. For the majority of the audience, this is the first time they will hear about the SLC. These sessions are designed to be brief and provide a high-level introduction to the following SLC areas:

- The evolution of the SLC
- The five phases of the SLC
- Primary SLC users
- Benefits of using the SLC
- Next steps for deployment

The audience for these communication presentations includes:

- CIO Leadership
- CIO organization
- Modernization Partner Leadership
- Modernization Partner Task Order Managers

### ***SLC Overview Sessions***

The SLC overview sessions are aimed at gaining awareness and providing a more detailed understanding of the SLC among all audiences. These 90-minute sessions are a more detailed version of the SLC briefing session and will be hosted through SFA Career Zone. The objective of these sessions is to provide information on:

- What is the SLC?
- The five phases of the SLC
- Key processes integrated in the five phases
- Critical SLC artifacts and what they are
- Benefits of using the SLC
- Primary SLC users



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The SLC overview session should be utilized as an opportunity to market the SLC to all audiences and generate enthusiasm for the continued deployment and use of the SLC. SLC Overview sessions will not make attendees “SLC Experts,” but are designed to give participants an overview of what the SLC is how it can be utilized. These courses should also be designed to help FSA attendees gain a positive attitude and understanding of the SLC.
